Our house use a septic system with sensitive pipes. Please only liquids down the drain. **Please discard all food debris, cooking oils, fats, grease & coffee grounds into the trash!** Thank you very much.



### **Accidents Happen**

We understand that accidents happen. If something happens to the house, its decorative elements, furniture or appliances, please make sure we're the first to know so we can find a solution.



### **Keep noise to a minimum after 10pm**

Our neighbours are very friendly and we maintain a good relationship with them. Out of respect to them, please keep noise to a minimum after 10pm until 08.00. This means also for using the swimming pool.



### **No parties**

This is not a party house, it is our home. We kindly ask that you do not use our home for parties or large gatherings. You are more than welcome to invite friends over during your stay, but parties are strictly prohibited.



### **No smoking inside**

You are welcome to smoke at the front of the house. Please ensure doors are closed before smoking. We do not mind smoking, but we ask you to observe this rule on behalf of the guests who will arrive after you.



### **Insects**

Thailand is a tropical country. Insects here are omnipresent. To avoid attracting insects such as ants into the house, please ensure all food scraps are disposed of into the trash and dishes are cleaned after eating. Leaving food or dirty dishes in the kitchen can attract ants into the house.



### **Air conditioning**

For the good of the planet - and yours and ours electricity bill! - please do not leave air conditioners running whilst you are out of the house, or whilst windows are open.



### **No additional guests**

This house is for a maximum of 2 occupants. No more than 2 persons are permitted to sleep over. Even if you have foreign guests only for one night, do not forget to send us or the property manager a copy of the passport and the duration of the stay. We have to register the person at immigration within 24 hours. If we will not do it, both parties will be fined by the authorities.
